

Editorial Guidelines for Diplomatist Magazine

Submission Requirements

Diplomatist magazine welcomes submissions for its monthly editions, special reports, and website. Authors are encouraged to contribute commentaries related to different topics on geopolitics.

Article Length

Articles for the magazine should ideally fall within the range of 900-1200 words.

Content Circulation

Topics for each monthly edition are circulated through e-newsletters. Authors may submit their own commentaries for the website related to different topics on geopolitics.

Style Sheet

1. Ensure original content.
2. Use UK English (e.g., organisation, standardisation, colour, labour).
3. Write numbers one to ten in words (except when depicting quantity).
4. Avoid special characters.
5. Avoid repetition of ideas or content.
6. Open abbreviations once at the outset and then use the abbreviation in subsequent text.
7. Avoid over hyphenating.
8. Use a long dash to connect two sentences.
9. Properly cite any referenced material from articles, websites, news websites, journals, etc., at the end with hyperlinks within the text.
10. Provide the following format when submitting an article:
 - Headline (Title of the article) - 6-8 words
 - Introduction
 - Subheads in the article
 - Conclusion
 - References in proper format with citations in the text
 - Two blurbs (highlighted text) - 10-15 words each

- Graphs and charts should be prepared in MS Office (Word/Excel) format.
- Images sent with articles should be high-resolution along with their source.
- Include contact details of the author with a mobile number, professional photograph, and a brief bio.

Keywords

Authors should provide six to eight keywords for their articles.
